**EDITORIAL REVIEW**

If you usually need a smaller sunglass frame and are looking for an affordable pair of shades, you might want to try Serfas Optics' Kontakt sunglasses on for size. The Kontakts are a unisex frame, but run on the smaller side so they fit comfortably on petite faces. Wrap-style glasses are often too large for small faces, but the Kontakts are held in place by soft elastomer temple tips that avoid creating pressure points. Serfas also used elastomer on the nose grips to prevent slipping, which does not work as well on the nose as it does on the temples.

Contact frames also come with **polarized lenses**, which are great for riding in bright, harsh sunlight-particularly when dealing with glare from the road-because they help reduce squinting and strain on your eyes. Polarized sunglasses often run a little pricey, so Kontakts are a viable option to toss into your bag. And in two different colors-tortise (brown lenses) and black (gray lenses)-you'll look good wearing them.

The only difficulties I had while wearing the Kontakts was that their
