

INSTALLATION

- 1 Remove old brake pad shoe fixing bolt. Remove old brake pad shoe and hardware.
- 2 Align new brake shoe and washers with brake arm. Shoes are right and left side specific. DO NOT MIX.
- 3 Make sure brake shoe surface is in the middle of the rim surface. Using allen key, tighten brake shoe fixing bolt.

3-STAGE MULTI-FUNCTION BRAKE PAD SURFACE

BLACK AREA - Crud removal removes contaminants from the rim surface just before braking.

GREY AREA - Max braking maximum surface contact for best braking.

TAN AREA - Noise reduction progressively reduces surface contact between brake pad and rim, eliminating noise and prevents pad deformation.
